
On August 17, 2006, the United States Trustee's Office, under the direction of the Department of Justice, appointed me as Trustee in the Chapter 7 bankruptcy case of the above named Debtors. I am charged with locating assets of the Debtors and pursuing lawsuits against other parties on behalf of the Debtors, in order to make payments to all creditors.

Essentially, there is an ongoing dispute between the Debtors, medical providers and ADP regarding the agreements between those parties. I have been thrust into the middle of this controversy and it is my job to discover the truth and pay creditors to the extent possible. Despite contrary instructions you may have received from your dentist or others, it is imperative that you continue to timely make your regular payments to Duvera Billing Services, LLC. **FAILURE TO REMIT YOUR PAYMENTS TO DUVERA BILLING SERVICES, LLC COULD RESULT IN ADVERSE REPORTING TO THE THREE MAJOR CREDIT REPORTING AGENCIES, AND/OR RESULT IN COLLECTION ACTIONS INITIATED AGAINST YOU.** A similar warning letter has already been sent to your dentist or medical provider.

Today there are eleven thousand patient accounts and competing claims between the patients, medical providers, Debtors, Duvera and ADP. With the cooperation of the American Dental Association, information regarding the case can be found at www.ADA.org.
